Subject: Weekly Update

PUBLIC WORKS

Operational Updates:

Utilities Division

- Water usage was 28.969 million gallons during this reporting period, December 5-11, 2022, down from 29.032 million gallons the previous week. The daily peak water demand of 4.387 million gallons was used on Sunday, December 11. There were 1.31 inches of precipitation during this reporting period.
- One hydrant was flushed.
- An estimated 1,383,422 gallons of water loss occurred, including one water main break.
- Crews responded to six sewer back-up calls and installed one, one-inch water service and meter.

Sanitation Division

- Solid Waste staff received three complaints, two for missed trash and one for missed recycling. Two recycle bins were distributed.

Street Division

- Marked twenty right-of-way locates.
- Responded to one callout to remove brush on the sidewalk
- Inspected twenty-five headwalls, cleaned seven headwalls, and removed five cubic yards of debris.

- Repaired utility cuts at five locations.
- Patched potholes at the 500 block of Linkcrest at Softwood, and the 600 block of Cedar Ridge.
- Continued removing asphalt, concrete, and dirt from the spoil yard at the Service Center. One hundred eighty-six truckloads have been removed, and 14 loads remain.

CIP Construction:

- **E. Danieldale Rd. Reconstruction and Utility Improvements Project (Main St. to US-67)** – M-CO, Pavecon's subcontractor, continued the 16-inch and 18-inch water main installation.

- **FY22 Pipe bursting** – Vortex is installing sanitary sewer mains by pipe bursting along E. Center St. in the Forest Hills subdivision.



Public Works in action



- **The Highway 67 Green Ribbon Construction Project** – Green Ribbon Project construction commenced on October 11, 2021, and is substantially complete. Full completion, including seasonal planting, is scheduled to occur in Spring 2023. The landscape monument at Cockrell Hill Rd. and Interstate Highway 67 is complete and illuminated on December 14. The second landscape monument at Wintergreen Rd. and Highway 67 will be illuminated before Christmas Day.
- **Fire Station 271** – Council approved the Guaranteed Maximum Price agreement with CORE Construction in June 2022. The Construction Kickoff meeting was held on August 10, 2022, and monthly progress meetings began on September 7, 2022. Construction has commenced. The Fire Station 271 Groundbreaking Ceremony, previously scheduled for December 1 was canceled for safety reasons due to the ground conditions caused by recent rains and will be rescheduled. Completion of the fire station is slated for Fall 2023.




Other Construction

- **ONCOR Transmission Line Work at W. Camp Wisdom Rd. and N. Cedar Ridge** – Much of the work to replace transmission lines along Camp Wisdom Rd. has been completed by Oncor's contractor. The contractor removed the tower foundations and is working on sidewalk repairs.
- **ONCOR Line Work in the vicinity of the Downtown District** – ONCOR is upgrading the electrical line along Daniel St., Main St., Center St., Freeman St., and Wheatland Rd. The upgrades will improve the electrical system's capacity in that area. Work has commenced.



- **TXDOT I-20 Construction Cockrell Hill Rd. to Hampton Rd.** – TXDOT plans to construct new service roads and ramps from Cockrell Hill Rd. in Duncanville to Hampton Rd. in Dallas to include new bridges across US-67. Following City Council Resolution in August, TXDOT will construct the US-67 Cockrell Hill Rd. Texas U-Turn on the southwest side of the bridge. The project was awarded at the beginning of December 2021. The Pre-construction Meeting with TXDOT and the contractor was held on February 1, 2022. Austin Bridge & Road, the contractor, started construction in April 2022, with an estimated completion date of January 2025. Austin Bridge is constructing the Texas U-Turn at Cockrell Hill and Highway 67.



FISCAL SERVICES

- **Municipal Court:**
 - Docket: 56 cases are set for court
 - Cases processed – 723
- **Utility Customer Service Office**
 - On December 6, 2022, the team processed 107 water disconnections for Cycle 1 customers with a past due unpaid balance. The service field crew replaced 5 customer metered curb stops and 3-meter box lids this week.

FIRE DEPARTMENT

- The Fire Department responded to 144 calls for service in the past seven days, which included:
 - 108 EMS calls.
 - 7 assist invalid
 - 14 motor structure fires
 - 2 building fires, which took place in DeSoto and Cedar Hill
- The Fire Prevention Division completed two inspections, five plan reviews, three system checks, and two Certificate of Occupancy inspections.
- The Department currently has two vacancies. There is a Civil Service exam scheduled for December 17 which consists of a written exam and physical agility test. There are 41 applicants; 80-90 applicants are standard.
- Firefighters Tony Jones and Taylor Arrington are attending Paramedic school.
- On-duty paramedics received ambulance documentation training this week.
- Chief Rohde opened the Emergency Operations Center at a Level 3 after monitoring the storms on December 13. 14 tornadoes appeared in North Texas during the severe weather event; Duncanville was fortunately unaffected.
- Emergency Management Operations Coordinator, Lauren Sanchez, is attending a Logistics training class for emergency operations center management.

POLICE DEPARTMENT

COMMUNITY CORNER

- Sergeant Adrian Tijerina and Officer Rogelio Hernandez attended a law enforcement recruiting event in Los Angeles, California and spoke to several certified law enforcement officers who are looking to relocate to Texas.
- The records department attended training with the Texas Law Enforcement Records Association. Staff learned valuable information on expunctions, juvenile, and open records.

PERSONNEL

- We will be hosting a civil service exam on January 21, 2023.
- Cadet Brandon Dunn completed his field training program and has been assigned to a patrol shift.
- Cadet Jessica Determan graduated from the police academy. She has started in-service training and will start the field training program in January.
- Training and Personnel are actively conducting background investigations on applicants.
- We currently have 9 openings for sworn personnel.



DEVELOPMENT SERVICES

Economic Development

- The department participated in the District 4 Community Connect hosted by Councilmember Karen Cherry.
- Agenda items are prepared for the December 20 City Council meeting.
- The team met with a local business owner to discuss expansion and retail center revitalization.
- The team met with a business to discuss expansion that would bring a high-quality restaurant to Duncanville, a result of the Golden Plate initiative.
- We continue to conduct interviews for the Special Event Planner position.
- We continue to work on efforts advancing Project Skyline.

Building and Inspections

- A total of 1,853 single-family rental properties have been registered to date; zero new property has been registered since the last update. Twenty inspections were completed since the previous update. One passed, seven failed, and twelve were canceled. The primary reasons for the failed inspections were absence of GFCI protection, missing carbon monoxide and smoke detectors. A total of 1,316 Certificates of Occupancy have been issued since the inception of the Single-Family Rental Registration Program.
- Since the start of active lien collection in 2019, \$384,251.30 has been collected. A total of \$12,232.03 has been collected since January 1, 2022, including \$0.00 this week.
- This week 65 permits were issued, and 158 inspections were conducted.
- To date we have inspected 11 mobile vending units. 0 mobile vending units were inspected this week.

Neighborhood Services

- Neighborhood Service Officers conducted 57 inspections, including re-inspections, and have a total of 25 open cases.
- Staff attended the District 4 Community Connect event hosted by Councilmember Karen Cherry. Staff informed residents on city wide updates related to Development Services, including Wheatland Plaza and See Click Fix, and general responsibilities of the department.

 - A preliminary meeting was held on July 12.
 - A pre-development meeting was held on August 22 and November 28.
 - Clients are working on engineering and will be submitting permits soon.

 - Recommended for approval at the Planning and Zoning meeting on October 24.

 - The building permit application was submitted. The architectural and engineering plans are being reviewed by staff.

 - Replat was approved November 28 at the Planning and Zoning meeting.
 - Zoning change is scheduled for Planning and Zoning meeting on December 12.
- **Ongoing:**
 - **Comprehensive Plan Five-Year Update:**
 - Planning is at the beginning stages of updating the Comprehensive Plan.
 - Planning and Zoning Commission is focusing on the Downtown District area, discussing the incorporation of new areas, and considering ways to incorporate green energy.
 - Staff recommendations for updates to the Zoning Ordinance will eventually become a part of this process.
 - **Short-Term Rental Registration Program:**
 - Six final notices and four initial notices were mailed on August 2.
 - Four properties are going through the Specific Use Permit process.
 - One property is no longer operating as a short-term rental and four properties have registered as long-term rentals.
 - Four property owners have not responded.
 - Four properties were granted a Specific Use Permit by the Council.
 - There are approximately thirteen short-term rentals in Duncanville.




