DEVELOPMENT SERVICES

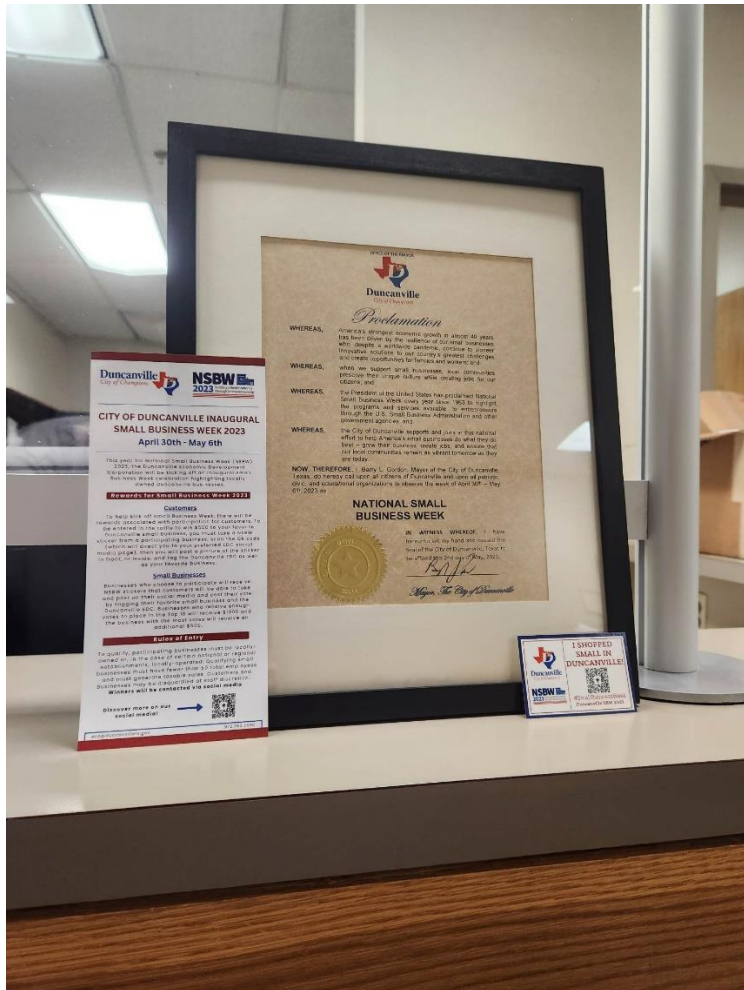
Economic Development

- Presented the Economic Development Corporation (EDC), Hotel Occupancy Tax (HOT), and Tax Increment Financing (TIF) funds to the public at the community budget town hall April 27.
- Ongoing discussions / progress on the following projects
 - Canard
 - Chart
 - Arcade
 - Skyline + Room
- Worked on implementation of Star Transit after City Council approved the interlocal cooperative agreement.
- Construction is coming along nicely on the new development at 300 West Highway 67. Signage is up and visible from Highway 67, as well as on the building:





- Staff accepted the proclamation for National Small Business Week, April 30 to May 6, at the May 2 City Council meeting.



Neighborhood Services

- Neighborhood Services Officers conducted 73 inspections, including re-inspections, and have 27 open cases.

Building and Inspections

- A total of 1,895 single-family rental properties have been registered to date; zero new properties were registered this week. Twenty-four inspections were completed since the previous update; eighteen passed and six failed. The primary reasons for the failed inspections were the absence of GFCI protection, as well as missing carbon monoxide and smoke detectors. A total of 1,429 Certificates of Occupancy have been issued since the inception of the Single-Family Rental Registration Program.
- Since the start of active lien collection in 2019, \$388,770.98 has been collected. A total of \$16,752.01 has been collected since January 1, 2022. This week we collected \$1348.06.
- This week 44 permits were issued, and 108 inspections were conducted. Thirteen mobile vending units have been inspected to date, including two this week.

Health Inspections

- Our Health Inspector conducted one routine inspection, one follow-up inspection, and one plan review.

Planning and Zoning

- **Items tracking for May 8 Planning and Zoning meeting:**
 - Request to rescind existing Specific Use Permit at 707 Center Ridge Drive to allow for the use of a child care facility and daycare.
 - Tracking for June 6 City Council meeting.

- Request for a text amendment to add and define the land use, Temporary Workforce Housing, which will allow the rental of a residential unit offered for rental to guests for residential purposes for a period of more than thirty (30) nights but less than six (6) months. Such rentals may include a shared room, a single room, or the entire dwelling unit. These uses are conducted by the homeowner or tenant, not by a hotel or other business. Such use will require a Specific Use Permit “SUP” within the SF-43, Single Family Residential District; SF-13, single Family Residential District; SF-10, Single Family Residential District and SF-7, Single-Family Residential District.
 - Tracking for June 6 City Council meeting.

 - A site plan was submitted on March 20.
 - Staff provided comments on March 28.
 - A revised plan was submitted on April 6 and is under review.
 - New Development at 1411 North Duncanville Road:
 - A pre-development meeting was held on April 24.
 - New Development at 1410 South Clark Road:
 - Plans were submitted on April 11.
 - Staff sent comments to developer on May 4.

Parks and Recreation

- Smith Lawn and Tree Service began tree pruning in preparation for the summer celebrations.
- Amphitheatre Lighting Project – 85% complete. City staff completed their portion of the project, and Olson Electric will begin working on their part next week. Thank you to the Streets Department for assisting with concrete cutting and removal.

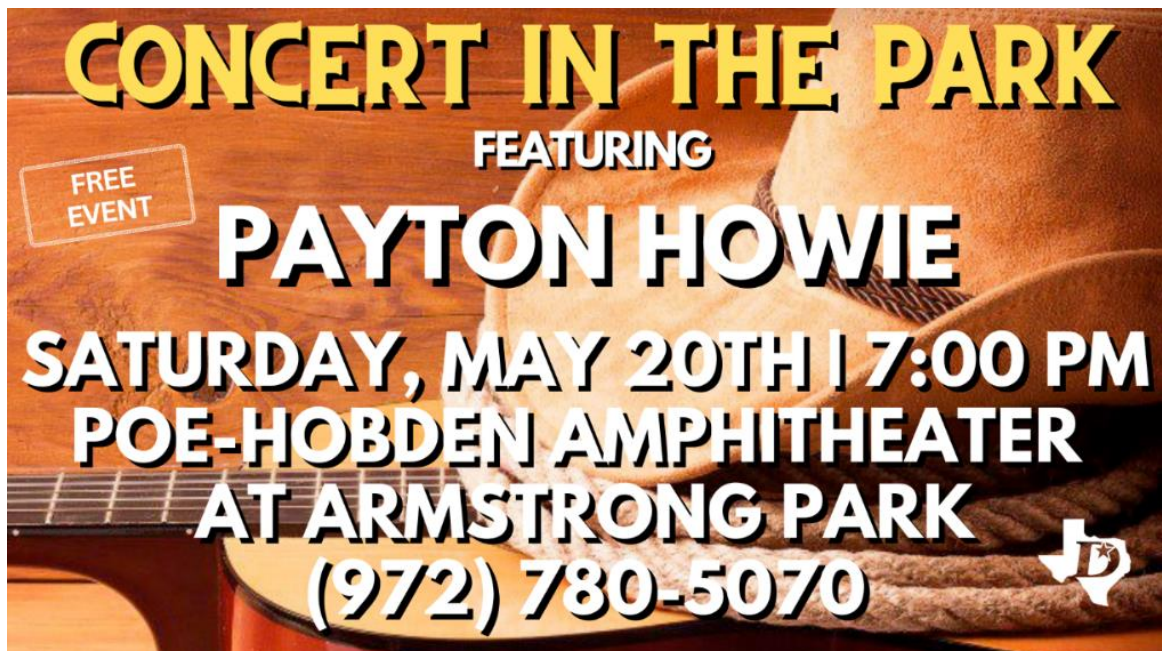

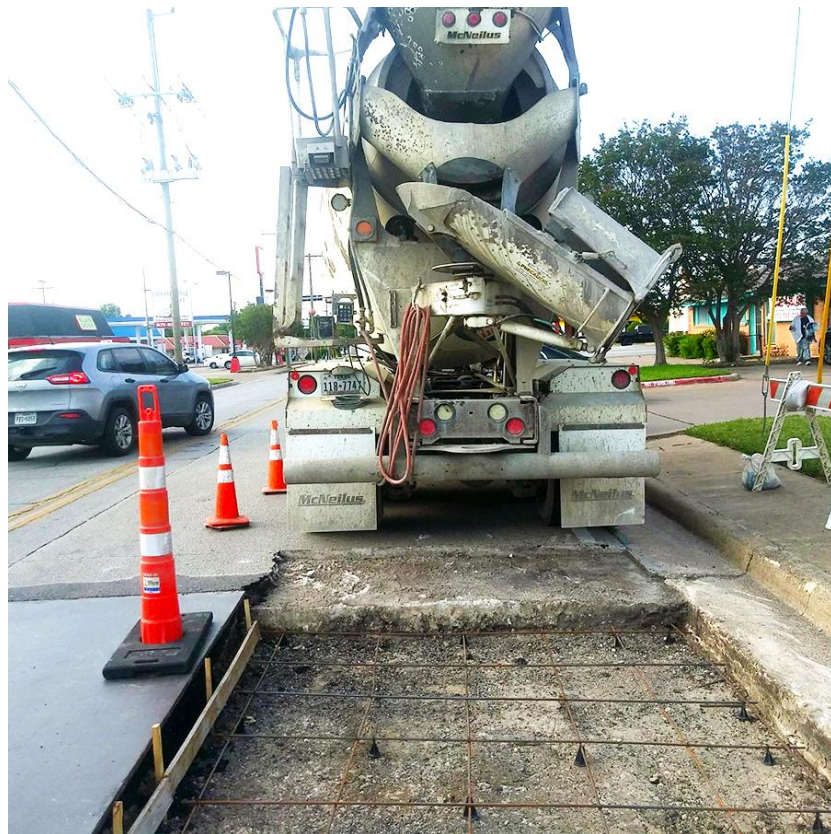


PUBLIC WORKS

Operational Updates:

Street Division

- Leveled asphalt pavement on London.
- Marked three storm sewer locates.
- Removed blockages from seven headwalls, totaling three cubic yards of debris.
- Completed drive approach tie-in on London.
- Flushed clogged drainage culverts on Roundtop.
- Completed utility cut repair on Oriole.

Utilities Division

- Water usage was 28.497 million gallons during the reporting period of April 24-30, down from 31.387 million gallons the previous week. The daily peak water demand of 4.699 million gallons occurred on Sunday, April 30. There were 2.20 inches of precipitation during this period.
- An estimated water loss of 54,250 gallons occurred.
- Fourteen fire hydrants were flushed, and two valves were exercised.
- Crews responded to two sewer backup calls. Cleaned 4,250 ft. of sewer line in the Penn Springs and Skyview Estates. Sewer main cleaning helps to reduce sanitary sewer overflow events.

Sanitation Division

- The Solid Waste Division received five calls regarding the solid waste pick-up schedule and three brush complaints. Four recycle bins were distributed to residents.

CIP Construction:

- **E. Danieldale Rd. Reconstruction and Utility Improvements Project (Main St. to US-67)** – Paving of the driveway approaches has begun. The driveway approaches at Sunset Village and Wells Fargo Bank were poured on May 3. PaveCon continues to haul off concrete and debris from the drop yard. The fence contractor has set the poles for the chain link fence that will be located adjacent to the Danieldale Pump Station and ground storage tanks. Grading for the sidewalks to be located on the south side of Danieldale has begun.

FIRE DEPARTMENT

- The Fire Department responded to 137 calls for service in the past seven days, which included:
 - 102 EMS calls
 - 1 structure fires
 - 2 vehicle fires
 - 1 brush fire
 - 18 motor vehicle accidents
 - 7 requests for assistance
- The Fire Prevention Division completed four routine inspections, four Certificate of Occupancy inspections, attended five pre-development meetings, and conducted six plan reviews.
- The Department has three vacancies. However, one of our firefighters/paramedics tested for the Plano Fire Department and has turned in his resignation letter. His last day will be May 13.
- The Department is currently working with HR to schedule a new Civil Service Entrance Exam. We are trying to schedule June 3, 2023, for a test date.

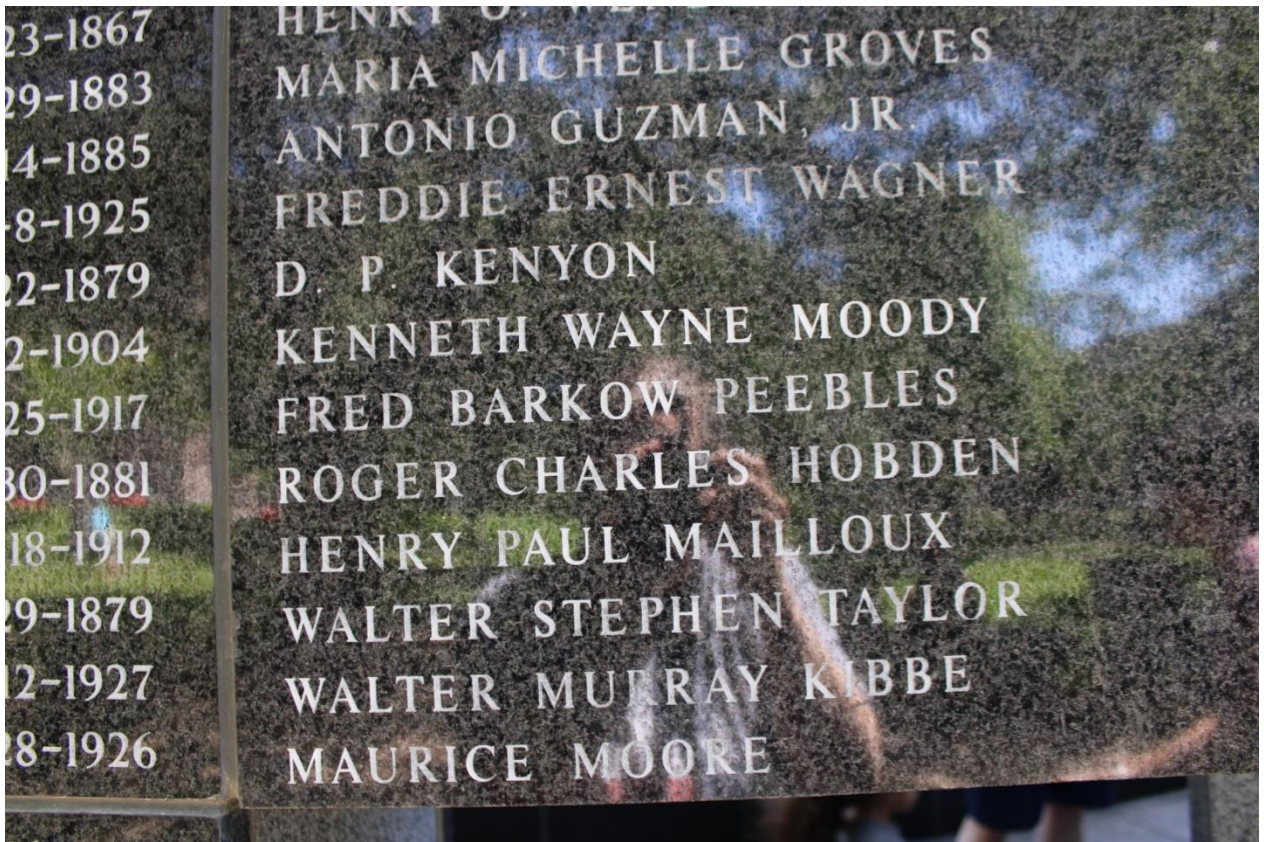
PERSONNEL

COMMUNITY CORNER

- Detective Pudgurney and Officer Johnson submitted 30 firearms to the ATF for National Integrated Ballistic Information Network (NIBIN) testing. NIBIN testing allows law enforcement agencies to find matches in the tested firearms to link to criminal cases nationwide. These firearms were either found, recovered, or seized as evidence.
- Officer Pineda assisted the Cedar Hill Police Department in capturing an aggravated assault suspect. Due to the recently acquired License Plate Reader (LPR) technology, Officer Pineda received an alert the suspect was actively traveling to his residence in Cedar Hill. She alerted the Cedar Hill Police Department, who was able to intercept the suspect.
- Police Honor Guard Members Officer Ralston Marshall and Officer Ambrosio Hernandez attended the Texas Police Officers Memorial in Austin, Texas. Attached are pictures of the names of Sergeant Poe and Officer Hobden on the memorial wall.
- The Police Department will hold its annual National Police Officers Memorial event to honor our fallen officers on Monday, May 15th, at 6:00 p.m. The ceremony will be held in front of the Police Department.

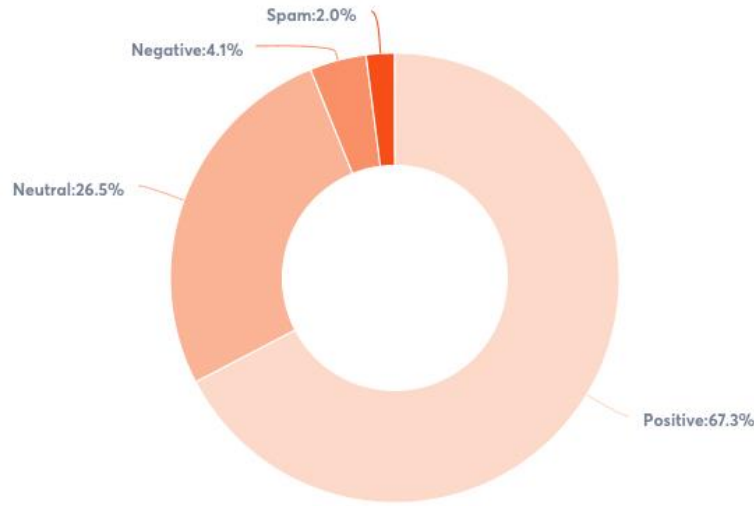
