



PUBLIC WORKS

Street Division

- Removed fallen trees, totaling 51 cubic yards, from rights-of-way on Candlelight, Athenia Way, Valleyview, S. Main, Blanco, and near the intersection of Cedar Hill and Danieldale.
- Patched 44 potholes in various locations.
- Repaired utility cut on Hitchcock.
- Inspected 43 headwalls: cleaned 18 and removed 25 cubic yards of debris.
- Marked 13 right-of-way locates.
- Responded to two callout requests to remove fallen trees from rights-of-way on Azalea and Valley Hill. Five cubic yards of tree debris were removed.
- Viking Construction continued micro-surfacing various streets throughout the city. Viking will micro-surface the remaining streets: Hill City, E. Fairmeadows, Smith, and Lime Leaf, completing the FY23 micro-surfacing project next week.

Utilities Division

- Water usage was 27.755 million gallons during this reporting period, March 20-26, down from 28.023 million gallons the previous week. The daily peak water demand of 4.243 million gallons occurred on Sunday, March 26. There were 0.12 inches of precipitation during this reporting period.
- Twelve hydrants were flushed, and seven valves were exercised.
- An estimated water loss of 71,112 gallons occurred, including two water main breaks.
- Crews responded to five sewer backup calls, cleaned 4,875 feet of sewer line in WD Basin (Greenbriar addition) and televised 162 feet of sewer lines.

Sanitation Division

- The Solid Waste Division received five calls regarding the solid waste pick-up schedule and five complaints (two trash, two brush, and one recycle). Two recycle bins were distributed to residents.
- The Household Hazardous Waste Event was held on March 25, 2023. Representatives from Dallas County, Good Earth, and twenty city staff members from multiple departments worked the successful event and serviced 407 households.
- Operation Clean Duncanville will be held Saturday, April 1, 2022, from 8:00 a.m. to 1:00 p.m. at James Collins Blvd. & Armstrong Park. Participants can shred documents and dispose of brush, bulk trash, and old electronics (\$1 per inch charge for tube-style TVs).



CIP Construction:

E. Danieldale Rd. Reconstruction and Utility Improvements Project (Main St. to US-67) – The subgrade is 99% complete. Nighttime paving will occur on Danieldale Road, between Main St. and Highway 67, from April 3rd through April 7th, between 9 a.m. and 5 p.m. The road will be closed during this time. Sunset Village residents and visitors may access the development from the Highway 67 frontage road. Pavecon provided a copy of the nighttime pour/traffic re-route notification letter to affected residents and businesses. The letter also be distributed 72 hours before work commences. Additionally, Pavecon will set up message boards announcing the nighttime closures. Schedule can be delayed due to rain events and concrete or other supply issues.





The landscape monuments at Cockrell Hill Rd. and Highway 67 are complete. Both monuments are permanently illuminated.




 Fire Station 271 – Council approved the Guaranteed Maximum Price agreement with CORE Construction to construct the new Fire Station 271 in June 2022. The Construction Kickoff meeting was held on August 10, 2022, and monthly progress meetings started on September 7. Construction has commenced. The Fire Station 271 Groundbreaking Ceremony is being rescheduled. CORE Construction continues erecting the building and has begun roof insulation. Completion of the fire station is slated for Fall 2023.

Other Construction

 TXDOT I-20 Construction Cockrell Hill Rd. to Hampton Rd. – TXDOT plans to construct new service roads and ramps from Cockrell Hill Rd. in Duncanville to Hampton Rd. in Dallas to include new bridges across US-67. Following City Council Resolution in August, TXDOT will construct the US-67 Cockrell Hill Rd. Texas U-Turn on the southwest side of the bridge. The project was awarded at the beginning of December 2021. The Pre-construction Meeting with TXDOT and the contractor was held on February 1, 2022. Austin Bridge & Road, the contractor, started construction in April 2022, with an estimated completion date of January 2025. The Texas U-Turn at Cockrell Hill and Highway 67 is under construction.




