## **POLICE DEPARTMENT**

### **PERSONNEL**

## **PARKS AND RECREATION**

### **Parks:**

- The Armstrong Park Poe-Hobden Amphitheater shade canopy is being replaced today with the financial assistance of the DCEDC. Its arrival was overdue due to manufacturing delays; however, it will be fully installed this week in preparation for the July 4th Celebration. The new forest green color will match the new Kidsville playground and has a higher UV resistance for longevity.
- Preparations are underway for this year's Independence Day Celebration to be held on Tuesday, July 4th. The fencing utilized for Juneteenth will remain in place until the July 4th event. Armstrong Park remains open to the public.

### **Fieldhouse:**

- An air conditioning compressor in the green gym was damaged beyond repair due to a lightning strike on Wednesday, June 21, and will need to be replaced.

## **DEVELOPMENT SERVICES**

### **Economic Development**

- Assisted in coordinating Star Transit's public information sessions as a requirement for total program implementation detailed in the approved Interlocal Cooperative Agreement.
- Economic Development Administrator Clay Mansell presented an Economic Development Update to the Duncanville Lions Club on June 16.
- Staff met with a broker of a regional development firm to discuss opportunities in Duncanville.
- Staff attended a Development review meeting for Project Ranch.
- Housing cleaning items: collected signatures from businesses for development agreements, and generated Placer reports for Parks & Recreation for Juneteenth.
- Chick-fil-A in Duncanville is open!!! Located at 300 W Highway 67 next to the Costco and Navy Federal Credit Union.
- The Parks & Recreation team completed the installation of the new Poe-Hobden Amphitheater awning in Armstrong Park. This new awning was paid for by a grant from the Duncanville Community and Economic Development Corporation (DCEDC).

### **Neighborhood Services**

- Neighborhood Services Officers conducted 188 inspections, including re-inspections, and have 79 open cases.

### **Building and Inspections**

- 1,903 single-family rental properties have been registered to date; one new property has been registered since the last update. Fifteen inspections were completed this week; seven passed, eight failed, and one was canceled. The primary reasons for the failed inspections were absence of GFCI protection, as well as missing carbon monoxide, and smoke detectors. 145 Certificates of Occupancy have been issued since the inception of the Single-Family Rental Registration Program.
- This week 57 permits were issued, and 65 inspections were conducted.

### **Planning and Zoning**

- **Items tracking for July 10 Planning and Zoning meeting:**
  - Request for a text amendment to add and define the land use: Temporary Workforce Housing which will allow the rental of a residential unit offered for rental to guests for residential purposes for a period of more than thirty (30) nights but less than



six (6) months. Such rentals may include a shared room, a single room, or the entire dwelling unit. These uses are conducted by the homeowner or tenant, not by a hotel or other business. Such use will require a Specific Use Permit "SUP" within the SF-43, Single Family Residential District; SF-13, Single Family Residential District; SF-10, Single Family Residential District and SF-7, Single-Family Residential District. Request to rescind existing Specific Use Permit at 707 Center Ridge Drive to allow for the use of a childcare facility and daycare.

## **FIRE DEPARTMENT**

- The Fire Department responded to 153 calls for service in the past seven days, which included:
  - 90 EMS calls
  - 2 vehicle fire
  - 12 motor vehicle accidents
  - 5 requests or assistance
- The Fire Prevention Division completed nine annual business inspections, signed, and released one new Certificate of Occupancy, and attended four Pre-Development Meetings.

Upcoming Events –

## **PUBLIC WORKS**

### **Street Division**

- Responded to two callout requests to remove fallen trees from ROW at 400 S. Santa Fe Trl. and 510 Dean Ct., totaling five cubic yards of tree debris.
- Repaved two damaged lanes at 134 Naples Dr.
- Marked eight drainage right-of-way locates.
- Removed drainage blockage at 100-200 W. Redbird Ln.
- Street crews are constructing sidewalk improvements at the new fire station.

### **Utilities Division**

- Water usage was 31.738 million gallons during this reporting period, June 12 – June 18, up from 1.489 million gallons the previous week. The daily peak water demand of

4.969 million gallons occurred on Sunday, June 18. There were 0.25 inches of precipitation during this period.

- An estimated water loss of 31,500 gallons occurred.
- Nine fire hydrants were flushed, and four fire hydrants were repaired.
- Two new water meters were installed, and one service line was repaired.
- Crews responded to one sewer backup call.

### Sanitation Division

- The Sanitation Division received three calls regarding the solid waste pick-up schedule and seven complaints (two trash and five brush). Two recycle bins were distributed this week.

### CIP Construction:

- **E. Danieldale Rd. Reconstruction and Utility Improvements Project (Main St. to US-67)**

Grading, forming, and rebar for sidewalks continue; sidewalks are 90% complete. The landscape subcontractor continues to lay out and install the irrigation system. Eastbound lanes are scheduled to open on June 28, 2023.

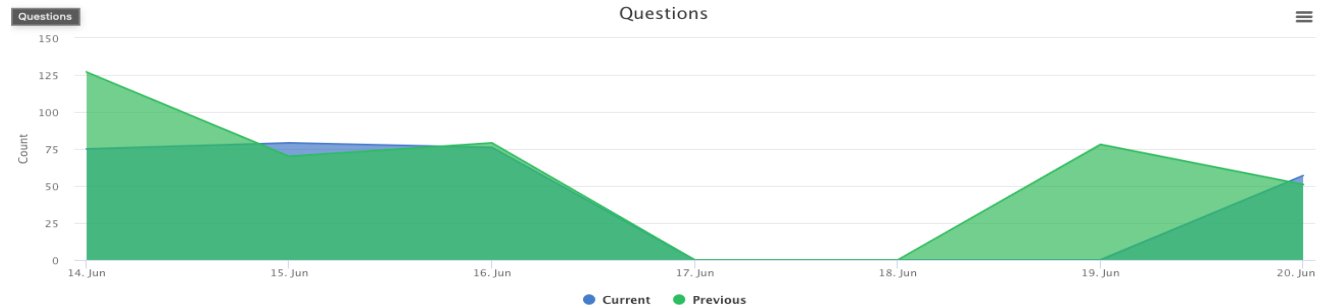

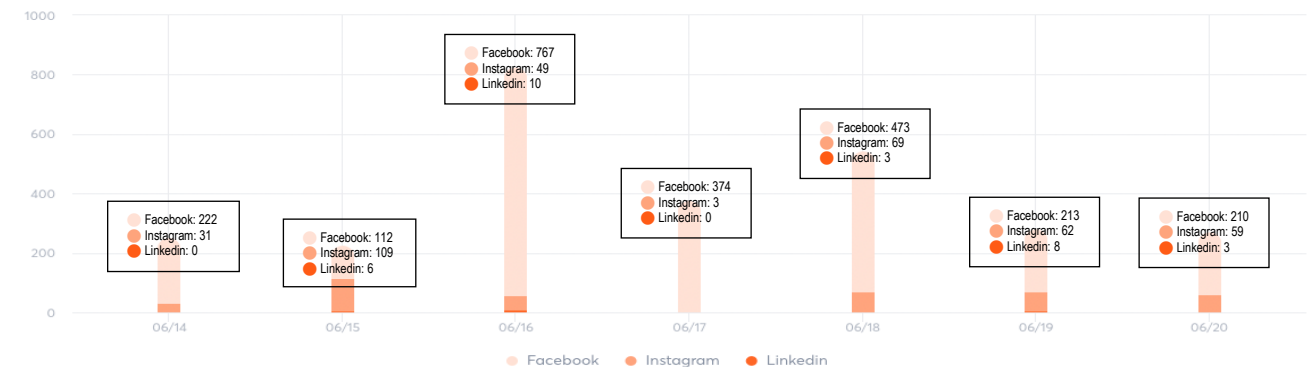

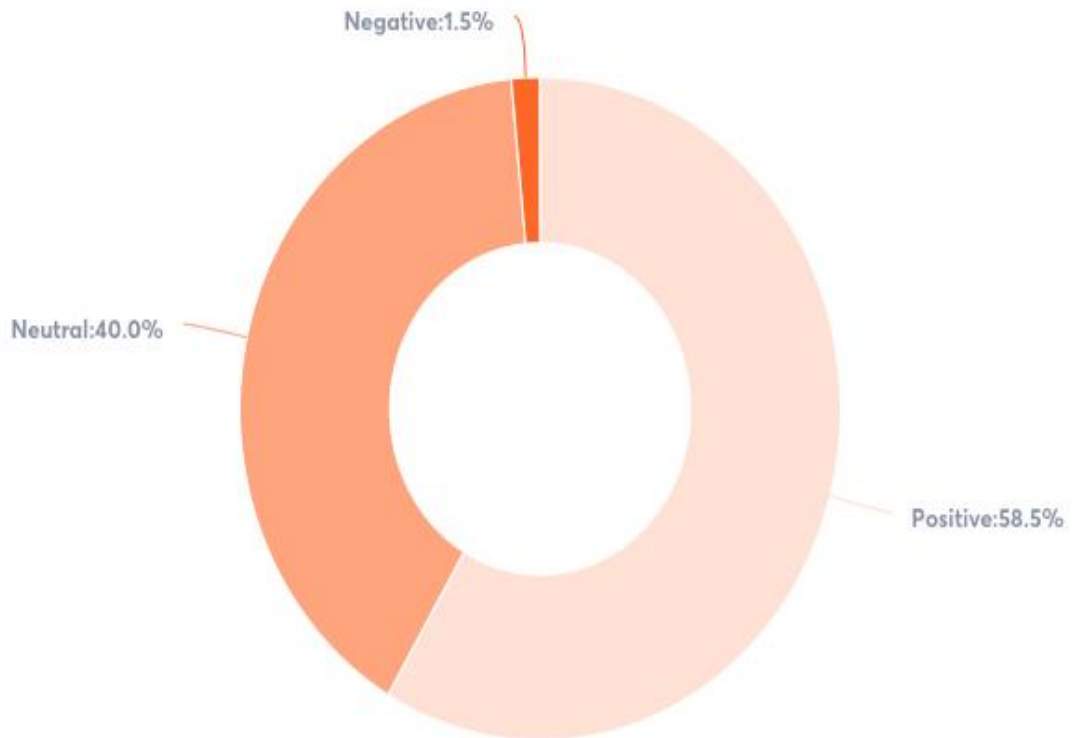
