Building and Inspections

- 1,935 single-family rental properties have been registered; one new property has been registered since the last update. Eight inspections were completed this week; six passed, and two failed. The failed inspections were due to the absence of GFCI protection and missing carbon monoxide and smoke detectors.
- 187 Certificates of Occupancy have been issued since the inception of the Single-Family Rental Registration Program.
- This week, 38 permits were issued.

PUBLIC WORKS

Street Division

- Crews reinstalled ADA ramp and repaired sidewalks on Walnut St.
- Locate and marked three utility drainage pipelines at various locations.
- Repaired 14 potholes on Duncanville Rd., Fairmeadows Dr., Redbird Ln., Alexander St., and Acton Ave.

- Crews removed a piano blocking the drive approach at an alley on San Juan St.
- Reshaped drainage ditch on Roundtop Blvd.
- Replaced missing storm drainage inlet manhole cover on E. Camp Wisdom Rd.

Utilities Division

- Water usage was 37.679 million gallons during this reporting period, November 27 –
 December 3, up from 36.311 million gallons the previous week. The daily peak water
 demand of 6.279 million gallons occurred on Friday, December 1. There was 0.52
 inches of precipitation during this period.
- An estimated water loss of 419,341 gallons occurred.
- Six fire hydrants were flushed, and three valves were exercised.
- Crews responded to four sewer calls and installed one new sewer service line.
- 14,300 feet of sewer lines were cleaned.

Sanitation Division

- The Sanitation Division received two calls this week (one scheduling and one Solid Waste Collection) for Solid Waste collection services.
- The Service Center distributed ten recycle bins this week.

Swan Ridge Reconstruction and Beaver Creek and Shady Tree Place Waterline Replacement Project

- The contractor has completed 99% of the sidewalks.
- SYB replaced the sod on both sides of Swan Ridge and is prepping for final inspection.
- SYB has requested a pre-final walkthrough inspection of the Swan Ridge construction this week.
- The contractor is completing waterline replacement at Shady Tree Place and Beaver Creek.

Fire Station #1

- Core's landscape subcontractor has completed the planting and irrigation.
- Core is working to complete the interior finish.
- o Furnishings have begun to be placed.
- IT is wrapping up the audio-visual and communications equipment installations.
- Generator start-up testing is 95% complete; we are awaiting test reports from Cummis.
- Contractors are working to provide perimeter fencing.

Cherry Alley Phase 1

- The project will reconstruct approximately 1,200 linear feet of alley pavement and needed drainage improvements between Cherry St. and Center St., from Alexander Ave. to N. Cockrell Hill Rd.
- Oncor has established a revised completion date of December 13, 2023, to finish the relocation of their power lines. Construction was slowed due to the rocky soil and underground utilities.
- Alley construction will resume in January 2024.

CIP Construction:

- E. Danieldale Rd. Reconstruction and Utility Improvements Project (Main St. to US-67)
 - Monument stone veneer has been completed.
 - The paving and utilities punch list items have been completed.
 - o The subcontractor is working on the remaining landscape items and punch list.
 - The project is substantially completed; staff is working with the contractor to complete the remaining items.

- The Fire Department responded to 123 calls for service in the past seven days, which included:

 - 1 passenger vehicle fire
 - 1 trash fire
 - 5 motor vehicle accidents
 - 5 requests for assistance
- The Fire Prevention Division completed nine inspections, conducted four plan reviews, and attended three Pre-Development meetings.
 - Investigations: Two
 - Vehicle fire involving a residential structure cause "INDECENDARY" (Arson) currently under investigation.
 - Commercial structure fire cause "UNDETERMINED" due to heavy damage in the area origin.
- Firefighter EMT Mason Quin is attending Paramedic School.
- The Department has three vacancies. The Department has scheduled a Civil Service entrance examination for December 9, and 24 applicants have signed up. The physical agility test will be on the same day following the exam.
- Paramedics participated in Continuing Education (CE) this week. The CE subject was Case Studies in Pediatrics.
- Firefighters and paramedics participated in the Regional Continuing Education training on Heavy Rescue Tactics to test their capabilities and equipment.

Passed Inspector II State Test.


